- *Monday, April 15 at 4:00 p.m. Re-salt and make the final trim of your hams.
- *Monday, June 3 at 4:00 p.m. Wash, net and hang hams on ham trees.
- *Monday, July 22 at 4:00 p.m. weigh hams, choose ham for fair competition, and take home second ham.
- Monday, July 29 at 5:00 p.m. Zoom meeting Marketing yourself and inviting potential buyers.
- Monday, August 12 at 5:00 p.m. <u>Location TBA</u> Speech contest. Record books due.
- **Members must attend 3 of the 5 meetings marked with an asterisk. Attending all 5 is encouraged.**

This project will cost \$70 which pays for 2 hams. One ham is for competition and sale at the Humphreys County Fair. You get to keep the other one. **Deadline to register is March 27, 2024.**
